










Function of Words / Parts of Speech

 Noun	A noun is a word that names a person, place, thing, quality, or act.
 Article	An article is any of the following three words used to signal the presence of a noun: <i>a, an, the</i> .
 Adjective	An adjective is a word that modifies (describes) a noun.
 Verb	A verb is a word that expresses action, existence, or occurrence.
 Preposition	A preposition is a word that shows the relationship of a noun to a verb, an adjective, or another noun.
 Adverb	An adverb is a word that modifies (describes) a verb, an adjective, or another adverb.
 Pronoun	A pronoun is a word that substitutes for a noun.
 Conjunction	A conjunction is a word that connects other words, phrases, or sentences.
 Interjection	An interjection is a word, phrase or sound used as an exclamation and capable of standing by itself.
