A 40-year Montessorian, speech and language pathologist, and learning disabilities specialist, she is a member of the AMS Board of Directors and a board member of the Academic Language Therapy Association. Dr. Pickering is an adjunct professor at Dallas Baptist University, where she received an honorary doctorate in humanities, and a clinical assistant professor at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center. She earned her AMS early childhood credential through the teacher education program at Montessori Education Centers Associated Seton in Clarendon Hills, IL. Dr. Pickering is a former board member and vice president of the International Dyslexia Association, former president of the International Multisensory Structured Language Education Council, and former board president of the Alliance for Accreditation & Certification of Structured Language.
